For each of the following expressions in Hebrew, determine whether it is a compound or a syntactic phrase. Explain.

a.	'bathing suit'	בגד ים
b.	'orange juice'	מיץ תפוזים
c.	'French flag'	דגל צרפת
d.	'birthday'	יום הולדת
e.	'bottle of juice'	בקבוק מיץ

In Biblical Hebrew (and in high registers in Modern Hebrew) the direct object can be attached to the verb. (The examples are given in transcription, using Modern Hebrew pronunciation.)

'I loved her'	ahávti ota → ahavtíha
'to eat them'	leexól otam $\rightarrow$ leoxlám
'he will bless you'	yevaréx otxa → yevaréxexa
'I saw him'	raíti oto → reitív
'vou tricked me'	rimíta oti $\rightarrow$ rimitáni

These objects are sometimes described as clitics. Is this a correct description? Why or why not?
