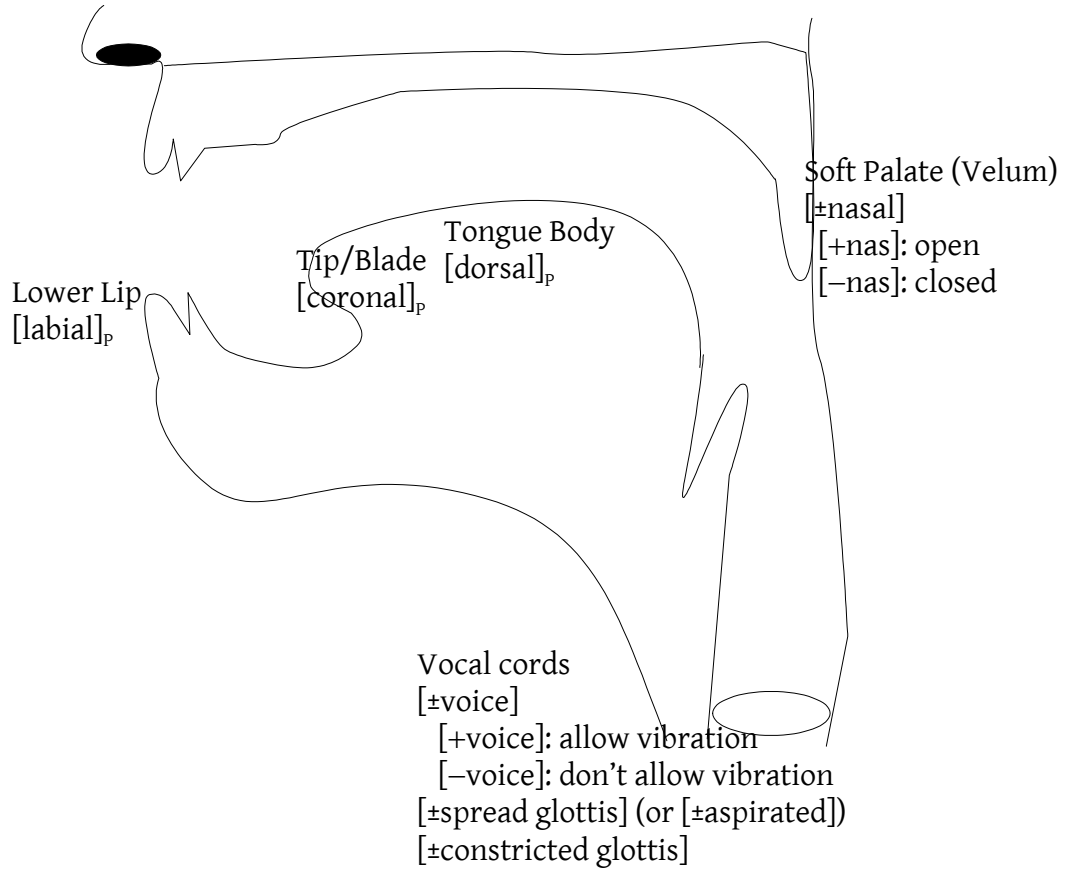


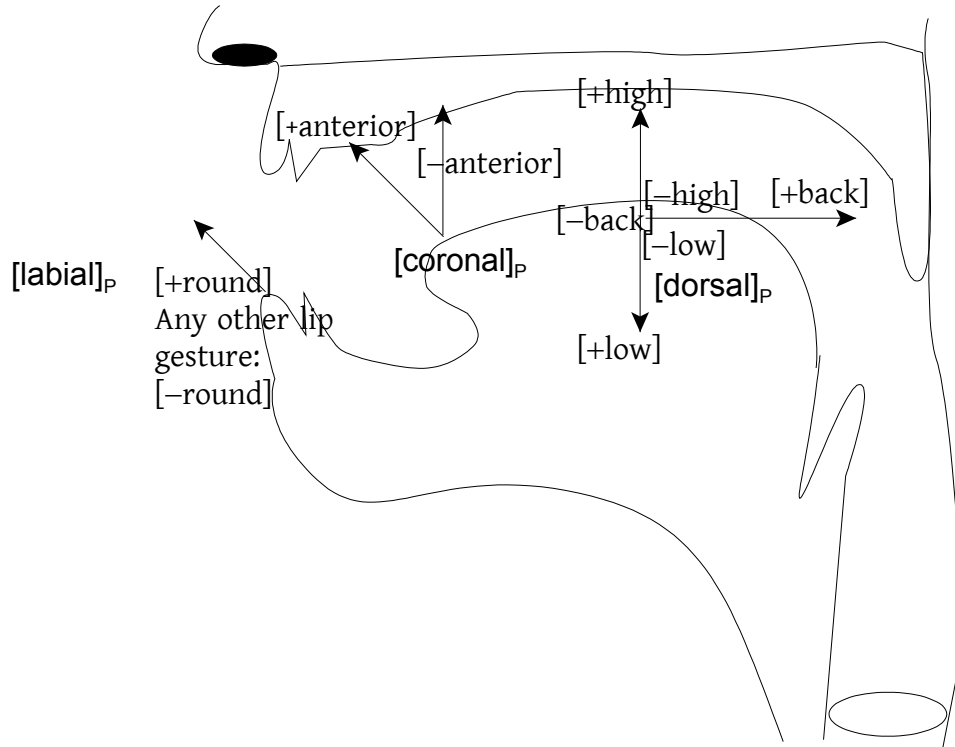
# Articulator Features, p. 1

---



These are the basic features. Each of the three “place” features is present if the relevant articulator is active. The specific action of the articulator is described by further features, which are said to be dependent on the main features. The important dependent features are shown on p. 2.

# Articulator Features, p. 2



Dorsal sounds and features:

	[-bk]	[+bk]
[+hi] [-lo]	high front vowels palatal consonants	high back vowels velar consonants
[-hi] [-lo]	mid front vowels no consonants	mid back vowels uvular consonants
[-hi] [+lo]	low front vowels no consonants	low back vowels pharyngeal consonants
[+hi] [+lo]	impossible articulation
